## DELAC Minutes April 18, 2017

Welcome	
Approval of Minutes	No Corrections were made to the minutes and they were accepted as presented. Rebecca Astorga motioned to accept the minutes as presented and Allison Banales seconded the motion.
School Reports	School reports were distributed and additional comments were made by the representatives present. Rebecca Astorga from Judson Brown announced that the school will be having several events in the upcoming months: March 31 Fix It Up Friday Campus Beautification; 4/17 Redlands Police Bike Safety Event; 5/2 Jag-A-Thon Fundraiser. All other reports were included in the written report.
Guest Presentation Resources for Immigrant Families	Peter Coonradt from Redlands Safe Haven presented information to the committee regarding resources for immigrant families that may be facing challenges. He shared that his organization partners with several other community organizations such as University of Redlands, the Immigrant Justice, and the Catholic Diocese of San Bernardino. He introduced Jennaya Dunlop who provided further clarification about the services that can be offered through their organizations. She shared that she has many resources regarding Emergency Response Assistance to families facing legal and deportation issues as well as legal services to assist with citizenship. She explained the roles and responsibilities of schools regarding interaction with immigration officers. She offered to assist with developing letters that explain parental rights and that clarify conditions for emergency pick up of students in emergency situations. She offered to share resources for humanitarian help and gave her card to the committee members for them to speak to her regarding specific challenges that they may have regarding parental rights. She also shared that the services she shared may not be something they need directly, but that they may know people in the community that may need her assistance. She offered to speak at ELAC meetings if needed. Many committee members had questions regarding the legal services provided. There was also a brief discussion about how the information could be shared within the community to reach the individuals that would need the services.
Parent Events	Rosalba presented specific information regarding the Parent-by-Parent Conference and the Multicultural Fair. She reminded everyone that it will be Saturday, April 22, 2017 at Franklin Elementary. The event begins at 9:00 and will end by 2:00. She gave information about the Keynote Speaker who is from Rialto Unified School District. She is a principal that has worked hard for her success. There will be several workshops including a presentation by the Mexican Consulate, an Update on LCAP, and other workshops that offer advice on how parents can support students. Rosalba then led the group through the procedures to vote on the student entries for the poster contest.
